<b>Bottlenecks:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Congestion at Cape Town improved significantly over the long weekend as the average berthing delays improved to <b>6,45 days</b> compared to the 10 of last week. The Port, however, remains on the "<i>Port Congestion Watch</i>" as more than <b>28 000 TEUs</b> are stuck at outer anchorage with a queue-to-berth ratio of <b>1.36</b>.</li></ul>
