• Congestion at Cape Town improved significantly over the long weekend as the average berthing delays improved to **6,45 days** compared to the 10 of last week. The Port, however, remains on the "Port Congestion Watch" as more than **28 000 TEUs** are stuck at outer anchorage with a queue-to-berth ratio of **1.36**.
