Operational comments and general observations

Weather and other delays:

- Average time at anchorage for container vessels as of 06:00 this morning: Cape Town (CTCT): 38 hours
- Estimated delays to the supply chain (time needed to clear cargo at anchorage)³: Cape Town (CTCT): 1 day
- Vessel ranging at berth 601 at CTCT delayed operations for approximately 9 hours from 21:00 last night to 06:00 this morning. Additionally, approximately 13 operational hours were lost over the latest 24 hours due to equipment challenges. High swells are still preventing berthing operations at berth 602; however, the swells are anticipated to subside around 12:00 today.

Load-shedding:

No load-shedding was reported at any of our national ports and terminals over the past 24-hour period.

Equipment Availability:


LC3 at CTCT went out of commission over the most recent 24-hour period, leaving the terminal with 7 out of 9 STS cranes available.
