Other Updates:

Operational comments and general observations

Weather and other delays:

- Average time at anchorage for container vessels as of 06:00 this morning: CTCT: 89 hours.
- The Maliakos experienced some berthing delays at CTCT over the latest 24 hours due marine equipment challenges.

Load-shedding: No updates to report.

Equipment Availability:

• Cranes LC1 and LC4 at CTCT went out of service over the weekend but were back in operation at the time of reporting this morning. All STS cranes are thus operational, despite a wire replacement that needs to be done on crane LC5. Additionally, 20 RTGs and six RTGs from the LA fleet are also in operation.

Staging Areas Update:

At the time of reporting, Pier 2 had 20 trucks in staging and 129 in the respective terminal queues this morning.
