Other Updates:

Operational comments and general observations

Weather and other delays:

- Average time at anchorage for container vessels as of 06:00 this morning: **Durban: 115 hours** (Pier1: 62 hours, Pier 2: 131 hours), **Cape Town: 89 hours** (CTCT: 114 hours, CTMPT: 39 hours).
- One vessel movement was delayed in Cape Town due to the berth not being ready.

Load-shedding:

No load-shedding was reported at any of our national ports over the past 24-hour period.

Equipment Availability:

- At the time of reporting, CTCT was operating with six STS cranes, 24 RTG's, and 42 haulers. Additionally cranes LC1, LC4 and
 LC5 remain out of commission. LC4 went out of service over the weekend due to the spreader dropping into one of the
 vessels but is anticipated to return to service during the course of the day. Berth 601 at the terminal is currently vacant due to
 the crane issues experienced.
- CTMPT had two operational cranes at the time of reporting this morning.
