Operational comments and general observations
<p>Weather and other delays:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Average time at anchorage for container vessels as of 06:00 this morning: Cape Town: 19 hours. CTCT experienced some operational delays which resulted in a below-par GCH of ~14. The reefer stack at CT MPT remains closed and will only reopen once more reefer plug points become available.
<p>Load-shedding:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> No load-shedding was reported at any of our national ports over the past 24-hour period.
<p>Equipment Availability:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> At the time of reporting, CTCT was operating with seven STS cranes, 23 RTG's, and 43 haulers. Cranes LC 1, 2, and 9 are all out of commission.
