## Other Updates:

Operational comments and general observations
<p><b>Weather and other delays:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>CTCT worked intermittently yesterday but unfortunately went windbound from 16:00 yesterday afternoon and remained windbound at the time of reporting this morning. The terminal reported that they would start working slowly if the weather permitted; however, industry should be aware that they are facing a level 8 weather warning for the rest of the day.</li></ul>
<p><b>Load-shedding:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>No load-shedding was reported at any of our national ports over the past 24-hour period.</li></ul>
<p><b>Equipment Availability:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>At the time of reporting, CTCT was operating with six STS cranes, 24 RTG's and 49 haulers. Crane LC3 remains out of service, with cranes LC6 and LC8 going out of commission over the latest 24 hours.</li></ul>
