### **Other Updates:**

Operational comments and general observations

#### Weather and other delays:

- Average time at anchorage for container vessels as of 06:00 this morning: Cape Town: 23 hours
- Two vessel movements were delayed at the Port of Cape Town over the latest 24 hours due to high swells, while operations at CTMPT were delayed for around three and-a-half hours due to strong winds.
- At CTCT, operations were delayed for around 13 hours, yesterday. Between 09:30 and 13:55 operations were delayed due to planned shiftings being revoked. Between 14:30 and 23:45, strong winds ensured additional operational delays.

#### Load-shedding:

No load-shedding was reported at any of our national ports over the past 24-hour period.

#### Equipment Availability:

- At the time of reporting, CTCT was operating with eight STS cranes, 24 RTG's and 49 haulers. Crane LC4 remains out of service, with no ETR communicated.
- CTMPT had three operational cranes at the time of reporting this morning, with only two operational spreaders.
