Operational comments and general observations
<p><b>Weather and other delays:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Average time at anchorage for container vessels as of 06:00 this morning: <b>Cape Town: 9 hours</b></li><li>• Further, minimal delays were reported across the national port system.</li></ul>
<p><b>Load-shedding:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• No load-shedding was reported at any of our national ports over the past 24-hour period.</li></ul>
<p><b>Equipment Availability:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• At the time of reporting, CTCT was operating with seven STS cranes, 22 RTG's and 49 haulers. Crane LC3 remains out of service. Additionally, the pilot boat at the port went out of commission yesterday and is anticipated to return to service tomorrow.</li></ul>
