## Other Updates:

Operational comments and general observations
<p><b>Weather and other delays:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Operations at CTCT will not take place between 16:00 and 20:00 this afternoon due to Management Engagement meetings taking place at the terminal.</li><li>• CTMPT experienced rain delays of about 12 hours and 15 minutes over the latest 24-hour period.</li></ul>
<p><b>Load-shedding:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• No load-shedding was reported at any of our national ports over the past 24-hour period.</li></ul>
<p><b>Equipment Availability:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• At the time of reporting, CTCT was operating with seven STS cranes, 24 RTG's and 44 haulers. Cranes LC3 and LC7 remains out of service.</li><li>• At the time of reporting, CTMPT had three cranes and three spreaders in service.</li></ul>
