Operational comments and general observations

Weather and other delays:

Average time at anchorage for container vessels as of 06:00 this morning: Cape Town: 14 hours.

Load-shedding:

No load-shedding was reported at any of our national ports over the past 24-hour period.

Equipment Availability:

- At the time of reporting, CTCT was operating with seven STS cranes, 25 RTG's and 44 haulers. Crane LC3 seemingly returned to operations on Wednesday, while Crane LC6 and LC9 remains out of service.
