<p><b>Weather and other delays:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Average time at anchorage for container vessels as of 06:00 this morning: <b>Cape Town: 8 hours.</b></li><li>• CTCT experienced vessel ranging on the Bear Mountain Bridge yesterday, and experienced vessel ranging on another vessel from 03:00 this morning until around 09:30. (by closure of this morning's daily port meeting, the vessel was still ranging)</li></ul>
<p><b>Load-shedding:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• No load-shedding was reported at any of our national ports over the past 24-hour period.</li></ul>
<p><b>Equipment Availability:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• At the time of reporting, CTCT was operating with seven STS cranes, 19 RTG's and 46 haulers. The pilot boat is back in service after going out of commission earlier this week.</li></ul>
