Equipment Availability:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">At the time of reporting, CTCT was operating with seven STS cranes, 24 RTG's (two additional RTGs expected this afternoon) and 55 haulers. Crane LC3 remains on long outage, while crane LC 5 will be out of service for the day shift today and tomorrow.CTMPT reported two cranes out of commission, with one expected to return by this afternoon.
