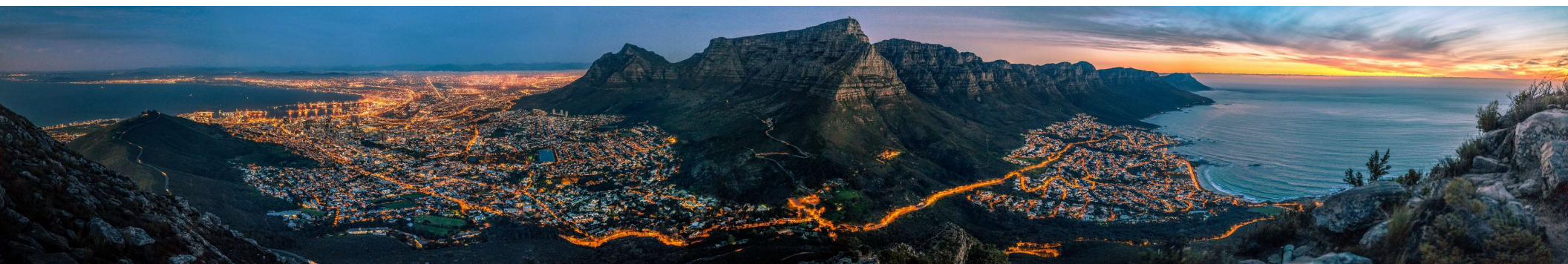
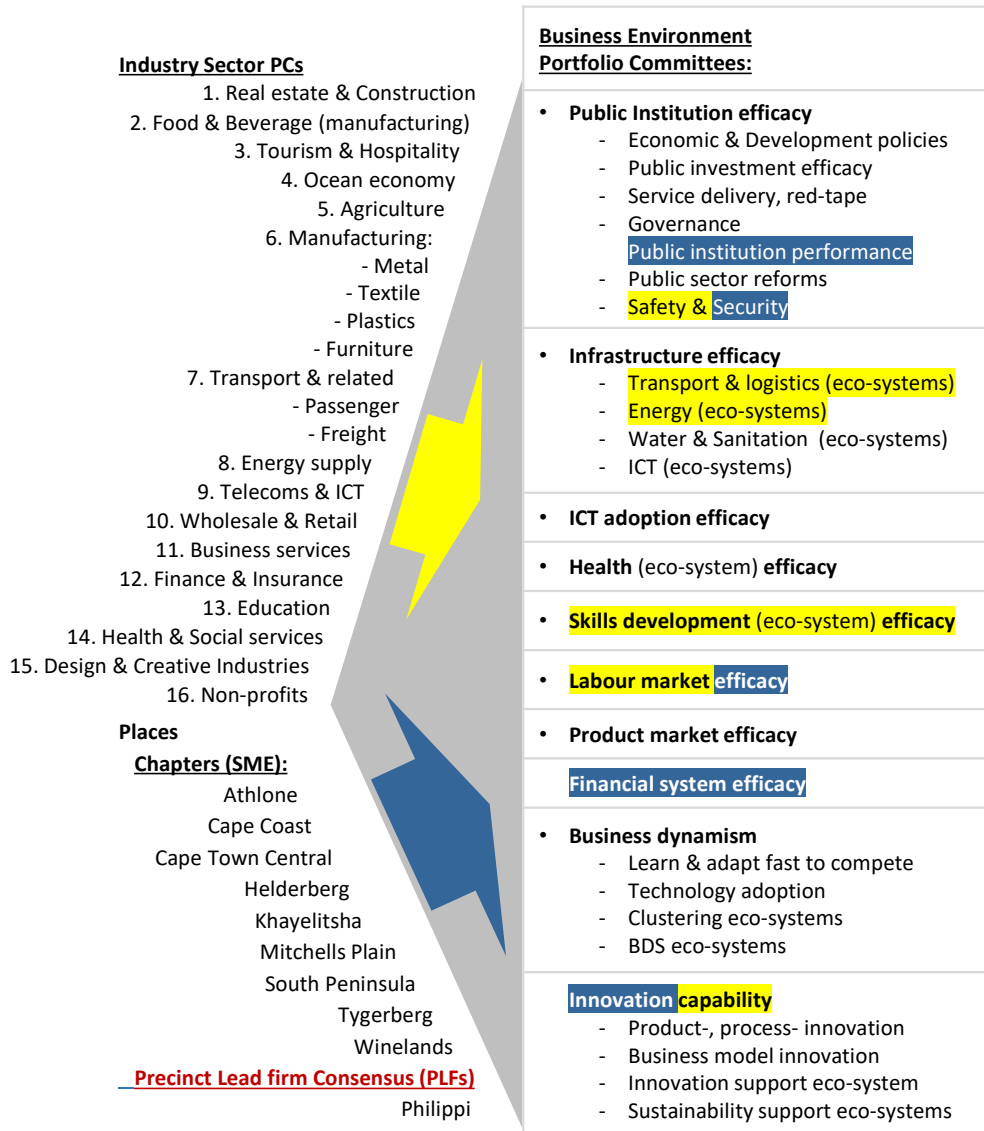

Purpose	Business environment improvement priorities are discussed by decision makers and experts to influence improvement.
Desired outcomes	Better options chosen to reduce systemic impediments to growth. <i>KPI: Number of changes affected.</i>
